Wallace & Gromit's Grand Appeal is the only charity fundraising exclusively to enhance and improve the quality of life for patients in the Bristol Children's Hospital. We provide much needed support for children and their families by funding:

- arts, music, play and educational programmes to help provide a distraction and a diversion to patients
- facilities and comforts for the family enabling parents and family members to stay with their child whilst in the Hospital giving them one less thing to worry about
- artistic enhancement of the Hospital environment to create a warm and welcoming atmosphere for all patients
- state-of-the-art medical equipment such as a child-friendly MRI Scanner, intensive care monitors and limb reconstruction equipment

Each year, the Hospital:

- treats over 70,000 children with a wide range of illnesses
 - has over 15,000 inpatients and day case patients
 - sees 30,000 or more children in the Outpatients Suite
- treats more than 25,000 children in Accident and Emergency

Why become a Guardian Angel?

The **Guardian Angels** regular giving programme supports the excellent medical care and treatment that patients in the Bristol Children's Hospital receive, but NHS funding alone cannot meet the complex and demanding needs of patients and their families. Additionally, medical excellence requires significant investment and substantial funding and by becoming a Guardian Angel you will help us to support Bristol Children's Hospital over the long term.

Regular giving can help in so many ways:

£30 could buy dvds or play materials to entertain a child for a week who is being treated for cancer or other serious disease requiring a long stay in hospital

£50 helps to provide a family with a room for one week in the hospital's family accommodation facility when their child is sick in hospital

£100 could buy a special doll which helps to explain medical treatments so that patients will understand what is happening to them and to help to relieve the fear and anxiety of medical processes

£120 helps to fund a music or play therapist for one day to work interactively with a patient. Play and music are vital aspects of rehabilitation and recovery for the patient

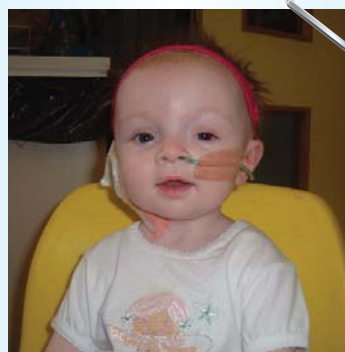
£500 could fund a specialist Sleep Alarm which is used on many wards to monitor a child's breathing whilst asleep

£1,500 could buy a Syringe Pump used to deliver chemotherapy to patients suffering from cancer

£2,500 could buy a Temporary Heart Pacemaker used to treat babies and children immediately following open heart surgery

£15,000 could purchase an incubator for the Intensive Care Unit. Incubators are designed specially to respond to a patient's temperature and humidity by a small sensor placed on the skin

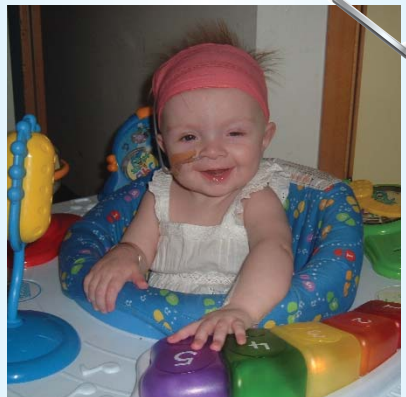

The Royal Hospital for Children in Bristol serves a population of 1.7 million children from Bristol, the South West of England and further afield and treats over 70,000 children each year:

The Hospital is:

- the regional children's hospital for Bristol and the South West providing seriously ill children with specialist care and treatment that local hospitals are not equipped to offer
- a centre of excellence in the UK for a range of services including the treatment of cancer, leukaemia and heart conditions. It is internationally recognised for the pioneering work of the Bone Marrow Transplant Unit
- the only designated paediatric Critical Care Facility in the entire South West Region. The Emergency Retrieval Service takes specialist staff to critically ill children in the region and returns with the patient to the Hospital
 - an acclaimed teaching centre for paediatric doctors and nurses. Its work has placed it at the heart of internationally significant research into diabetes, cot deaths, childhood cancer and leukaemia
